WORSHIP

The Ministry of Word and Sacrament is central to our congregation's witness in our Church. This is our first priority and greatest need for volunteers.

Worship Team - 🎵 Vocalists and Instrumentalists for 9:00am & 11:00am service of choice.

Acolytes - serve as assistants during the Sunday service. They process the cross and Bible and, from time to time other elements of the service. There is no age restriction for acolytes, only that they are able to carry the cross and elements and mature enough to follow instructions.

Altar Guild - sets the table for Sunday services and cares the items needed for worship and Communion together.

Ushers are essential to the smooth flow of our worship services. Ushers greet people, hand out bulletins, collect the offering and assist the order of congregants during Communion.

Greeters - Smiling faces needed before and after services to connect with guests and members.

Sunday Morning Prayer Leaders - One of the most important ways in which we respond to the Good News of God's Holy Word is through prayer.

Sunday Morning Readers - Proclaim God's word during worship by reading the Lesson.

Fellowship, discipleship and service opportunities to encourage and care for one another.

Intercessory Prayer Team - Mondays 10:00am - 12:00pm. Intercessory prayer is the act of praying for other people. The Lord instructed us to pray not only for our own needs but to reach out and pray for others. We invite men and women of the congregation to intercede on behalf of our church, nation, and world.

Hospitality Team - Join the COOS crew to help at Special Events.

Great COOS Bake-Off - Bake with us and help keep us stocked for Sunday Snacks.

Take Them A Meal - Make a meal for a congregant needing support and love after life moments such as a birth, illness or surgery.

In Christ's example, we are committed to serve and care for those who may not have any connection with us at all. We abide by our baptismal covenant to "seek and serve Christ in all persons" by reaching outside our walls in many ways.
